Position Responsibilities

Duties include feeding and handling of large animals, mucking, cleaning, and presenting information about barnyard animals, demonstrating historic skills, and speaking about our historic houses and their history to the public. Duties will also include presenting for school field trips and other groups, especially after COVID-19 restrictions are lifted. This position requires a background check.

Education and Experience Requirements

Experience working with large animals (particularly equines) is preferred. Prior experience interacting with the public is also preferred. Knowledge of historic skills is beneficial but may be learned on the job. Ability to do minor maintenance work is helpful. The employee must be able to speak English fluently and correctly.

A high school diploma or GED is required. It is preferred that applicants have at least some college.

Physical Demands

Applicants must be able to lift 50 pounds and climb fences. Work is mainly outdoors in all weather conditions. This position requires wearing of historic-style clothes. Burritt will help you acquire appropriate clothing. We are following COVID-19 health guidelines. Workers wear masks when interacting with the public, volunteers and with other staff members.

Hours and Compensation

This position averages 20 hours per week but may vary for any particular week. Weekend and holiday work is required, in addition to weekdays. Compensation is \$10.00 per hour.

This position qualifies the worker to participate in the Retirement System of Alabama (RSA).
